

ARTEMIs at EDITH Congress Amsterdam, 15th-16th July 2024

On the 15 and 16th of July, ARTEMIs will be presented at the second and final EDITH-CSA Ecosystem Meeting at the KIT Royal Tropical Institute in Amsterdam.

EDITH is a Coordination and Support Action (CSA), funded by the European Commission, aiming to leverage advancements in digital technologies, high-performance computing, and the availability and accessibility of research and healthcare data in Europe. The EDITH-CSA project has also been entrusted with bringing together the VHT ecosystem and guiding the collaborative creation of the Virtual Human Twin roadmap, which outlines the steps towards achieving the VHT's goals.

Last December, the European Commission officially launched the Virtual Human Twin (VHT) as its next flagship program. This initiative aims to unite stakeholders from academia, industry, and clinical fields within a collaborative environment to facilitate the development, credibility assessment, and application of digital twins in healthcare. The program encompasses a vision, dedicated project funding, and the creation of a research infrastructure designed to address a gap in the life sciences research infrastructure landscape in Europe.

The event will encompass a broad spectrum of topics associated with Virtual Health Technologies (VHT). These topics will span from clinical applications and patient adoption to policy considerations, ethical concerns, social implications, regulatory aspects, and the integration of VHT with current national and EU research infrastructures.

Keynote speakers will include representatives from the FDA and prominent clinical figures. The event will also feature a demonstration of the proof of concept for the EDITH infrastructure. Additionally, various interactive sessions, including break-out groups and plenary discussions, will be organized to facilitate the development of a consensus on the roadmap and its recommendations.
